**WHEREAS**, on October 14, 2025, Erin Kieser submitted Conditional Use Application CU-25-24 pursuant to Section 7.04(A) of the Orange Township Zoning Resolution, seeking approval to operate a home occupation at 7343 Africa Road.

**WHEREAS**, on November 20, 2025, the Orange Township Board of Zoning Appeals held a public hearing on CU-25-24. Following the hearing, the BZA approved Conditional Use Permit CU-25-24 finding that the proposed home occupation met the applicable zoning criteria but conditioned approval that no vehicles of any kind shall be parked within a thirty-foot (30’) distance from the edge of the roadway.

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**WHEREAS**, Kieser subsequently filed a Notice of Appeal to the Delaware County Court of Common Pleas.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,**

The Board of Trustees hereby **MODIFIES** and **APPROVES** Conditional Use Permit CU-25-24 for the property located at 7343 Africa Road, allowing vehicles to be parked within a fifteen-foot (15') distance from the edge of the roadway, as defined by where the curb meets the grass, directed towards the residence.
